

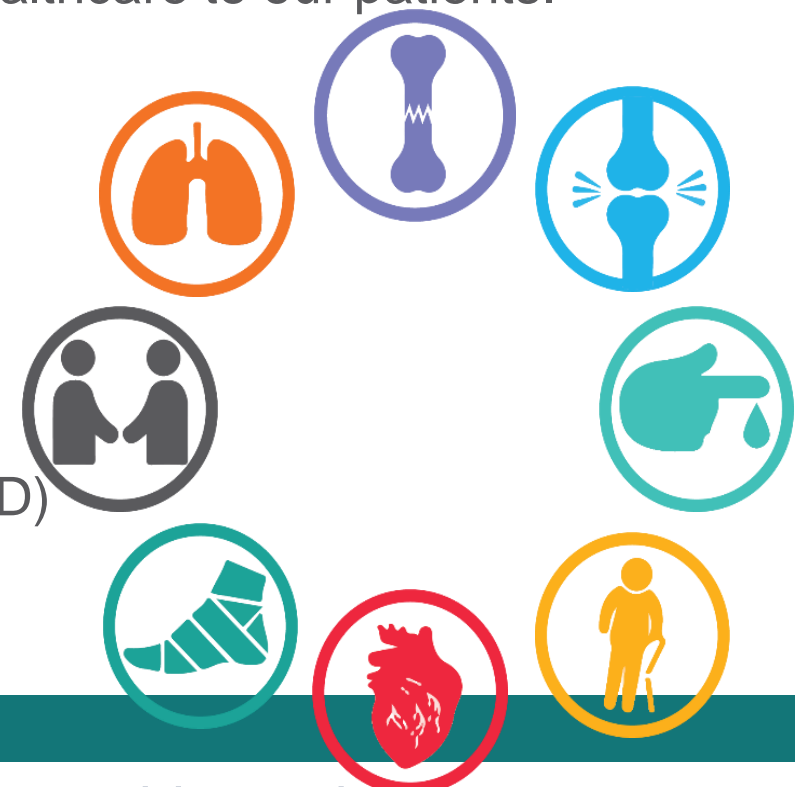

Leading Better Value Care (LBVC) is a priority initiative of NSW Ministry of Health (MOH). 8 areas of focus have been identified across the health system, encouraging a more collaborative, whole-of-system approach, delivering better value healthcare to our patients.

The 8 priority areas of focus for LBVC:

1. Management of Osteoarthritis (OACCP)
2. Management of Chronic Heart Failure (CHF)
3. Renal Supportive Care (RSC)
4. Inpatient Management of Diabetes Mellitus (IMDM)
5. Diabetes: High Risk Foot Services (HRFS)
6. Management of Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
7. Osteoporotic Refracture Prevention (ORP)
8. Falls in Hospital (Falls)



The purpose of the Primary Care Advisory Group (PCAG) is to provide a primary care perspective on the 8 initiatives with aim to **enhance patient care, health system integration, efficiency and improve the patient experience, across the health system.**
