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Who is the service for?

- People over 65 years
- At risk of hospitalisation or multiple hospitalisations
- Multiple complex comorbidities associated with disability
- Frailty, falls, unsteady gait or reduced physical mobility
- Common geriatric syndromes, incontinence or confusion.
- Weight loss with no obvious cause
- Dementia, depression, anxiety, cognitive decline or delirium risk
- Concerns about level of care patient receives at home or threatened dependence

The service provides:

- Comprehensive Aged Care assessment by experienced Aged Care Nurse Practitioner
- Assessment includes patient, family and carers.
- Recommendations and referrals for ongoing care and support or further assessment
- Consultation with GP and health care team
- Patient and carer education about early recognition of deterioration and planning for this.
- Follow-up, monitoring and case management according to priority
