How Can the Service Help Me?

Access to psychiatrists will support North Coast GPs in managing the care of mental health consumers. It is NOT a triage or referral service, nor an emergency service.

When Can I Call?

Between 9am and 5pm, Monday to Friday.

Can I Make Contact Any Other Way?

There are options to use secure messaging once you are registered.

How Do I Get Started?

Register online at gpsupport.org.au or call 1800 16 17 18 for registration help. You will need your AHPRA registration number handy.

What is the Cost Of The Service?

It is a free service for North Coast GPs.

How Many Times Can I Use the Service?

As many times as you wish.

Is This Service Only Available to GPs?

Yes, this is open to GPs who practise in the NCPHN area.
