Some residents have had questions about the vaccines. Others may have thought the virus didn't pose a big threat to them as someone living in a home.


However, the last 24 months have proved that being vaccinated against COVID-19 is our home's best protection — for you, your fellow residents, families and friends, and our staff.

A residential aged care COVID-19 outbreak remains a very serious threat for those that are unvaccinated.

Despite increasing outbreaks, COVID-19 deaths in residential aged care have dropped by 91% since vaccination rates have improved:¹
