



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

COVID-19 Vaccines Survey Healthy North Coast Game of Skill Prize

1. This is a game of skill. Chance plays no part in determining the winner. Each entry will be individually judged, based upon creative merit and the nominated organisation meeting eligibility requirements set out below. All entries must be by independent creation by the entrant. Entries must not have been published previously and or have been used to win prizes in any other competitions.
2. To be eligible for the prize, the nominated community organisation must:
 - Be registered in Australia as a legal entity. Legal entities include not-for-profit organisations, incorporated associations, and unincorporated associations.
 - Be supporting people living in the communities of the North Coast NSW, Australia.
 - Be contributing to better health for North Coast communities.
 - Be supporting between 30 and 5,000 people living in North Coast communities.
 - Have annual gross revenue of less than \$1 million last financial year.
 - Not be seeking funding for any programs or activities on our exclusion list.

What are examples of organisations you can nominate?

- Community associations
- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander organisations
- Cultural groups
- Sporting groups
- Registered charities

What programs or activities are excluded from the prize?

The prize is not available for the following:

- Medical research
- Programs promoting religion
- Programs or activities against vaccination
- Programs or activities that support an unhealthy lifestyle
- Charity works outside of Australia
- Sponsorship or fundraising activities
- Contribution towards capital projects, major equipment and refurbishments that are reliant on other funding and approvals being obtained in order to be completed.

3. Employees of the promoter and agencies associated with this survey (Healthy North Coast) are ineligible to enter the competition, as are their immediate families.

4. To enter, entrants must complete the Community Consultation on COVID-19 Vaccines online survey and answer the question (What are you most looking forward to when the world gets back to closer to normal?). Submissions can be written (25 words or less) or by video upload (max. 1 minute). Only one entry is permitted per person. The promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries.
5. The judges reserve the right to disqualify any entrant submitting an entry which, in the opinion of the judges, includes objectionable content. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. All entries become and remain the property of the promoter and the agencies associated with this survey (Healthy North Coast), Entry submissions answering the question "What are you most looking forward to when the world gets back to closer to normal?" may be used by Healthy North Coast in future communications.
7. Winner of the competition must be 18 years old and over and residents of Australia and have nominated a registered club, sporting club or community group to be the recipient of the prize. The winning entry will need to be verified that the prize is going to the community group and not an individual and that it is used for the betterment of the "group" not an individual.
8. The promoter reserves the right to withdraw or amend the competition as necessary due to circumstances outside its control.
9. The prize is non-transferable and non-redeemable for cash.
10. There will be one prize, to the value of \$2,000 as a cash prize donated directly to the registered, nominated organisation. The total prize value is AUD \$2,000 and is correct at the time of printing. These will be valid until the 13/07/2021.
11. By entering the competition, all entrants will be deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these rules.

13. Promotion commences 14th April 2021. Entries close 5pm 14th May 2021.
14. The information you are asked to provide to Health North Coast is personal information and is protected by the Privacy Act. Healthy North Coast will not disclose this information to other parties other than in accordance with the Australian Privacy Act. Your personal information to enter the prize draw is your name and email address, and this information will be destroyed following the winner announcement.
15. Entries will be judged by Healthy North Coast on 15/05/2021 and the winner will be notified in writing by email within 30 working days of the conclusion of the competition.
16. If Healthy North Coast is unable to contact the winner within 30 days of the draw and Healthy North Coast has made every effort to contact them with the information provided by the entrant, then Healthy North Coast will award the prize to another valid entrant.
