From administration, management, clinical and support staff, all people working in primary care can make an impact on patients' experience of inclusive care. Developed to strengthen inclusive healthcare delivery, this workshop explores the health needs, experiences, and priorities of trans and gender diverse communities, with a focus on creating safe, respectful, and affirming clinical environments.

Participants will build their understanding of gender affirmation, including social, legal, and medical pathways, and develop practical communication skills to support person-centred care.

Participants will hear from community voices and subject matter experts, explore real-world scenarios, and leave with actionable strategies to improve patient experiences and health outcomes.

By the end of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Understand key LGBTQ+ terms and identities.
- Identify the unique experiences, healthcare needs, and barriers faced by trans and gender diverse people.
- Describe and apply key principles in the provision of healthcare to trans and gender diverse people, under the WPATH Standards of Care.
- Explain the importance of inclusive care and its impact on health outcomes.
- Navigate common pitfalls and apply trans inclusive practice to health care settings.
